5 Hints for Success in Our Scholarship Competition - The selection committee's top tips

If you're looking for top tips on how to submit the best application, then you're in the right place. Read on for some insider info from our judges. . .

#1 Excellence, perseverance, and commitment

These are the 3 keywords that should guide you for your application. Show us how excellent is your academic record. A final transcript should be sent by the institution (Cegep or university of Quebec). Explain to us in which circumstances you had to demonstrate perseverance and how you get involved in your community. We want to see what you're passionate about and how you can maintain your efforts in spite of adversity.

#2 Make it personal

Use this opportunity to explain in a few words who you are, what inspires you to study, and how you are involved in your community; this is your chance to tell your story.

#3 Be concrete

Everybody wants to be the best in the competition, so be concrete and specific in your essay. Use significant examples to illustrate your points. Don't forget to add the reference letters.

#4 Keep it concise

When you're writing make sure you stick to the 100-word limit per topic. Remember that the shorter, the better!

#5 Most importantly, apply

If you don't take part you can't win – you have until 4 pm, Friday September 13, 2019 to apply. But be sure to meet the criteria : a full-time permanent resident or canadian student in the medical field or in health sciences registered in a CEGEP or university of Quebec. So what are you waiting for?
